Why?

“Collaborate behind the scenes with creators and brands. Gain skills in annotating, subtitling, analyzing, and editing videos—all from the comfort of your home.”

What Changed?

YouTube has announced that AI-generated videos lacking real human value won't be eligible for monetization. While many creators are panicking, smart freelancers are cashing in by working behind the scenes rather than chasing the spotlight.”

→ In 2025, YouTube rolled out stricter rules on AI-generated content, cutting monetization for auto-made videos. But here's the reality: you can still make money on YouTube and similar platforms—not by generating content, but by understanding and improving it.”

What Work Can You Actually Do



If you're hired to work on a YouTube video, there are several tasks you might be responsible for. These include:



Scene Annotation

Label what's happening
00:05 - Host introduces topic
01:40 - Transition to tip #2
02:15 - Emotional appeal begins

Subtitling:

Listen and type out exact dialogues (manually or using tools). Clean, clear captions.

Chapter Creation:

Divide long videos into chapters
"Intro, Story, Tips, Ending" with timestamps.

Shorts Clipping:

Watch long videos → pick out viral 30-60 sec moments.

Scene Understanding (for AI):

Label scenes by action, tone, movement
— companies train AI with this.

Google Doc / Canva For Samples

Basic English

Laptop or phone + internet

Free tools: YouTube, Descript, VEED, Subtitle Edit



How to Create a Sample Portfolio (Even Without Clients)

Step by Step

Open any YouTube video (5–10 mins)
Watch it fully and create:

A chapter breakdown
Scene-by-scene description (time-based)
1-minute short reel from best moment
Subtitle script for 1 minute

- Use Google Docs to create this file.
- Optional: Record yourself explaining how you broke it down.
- Save these into a Drive folder →
Send link in job applications.

How to Apply With or Without (Experience)

Step by Step

Step 1: Make a Fiverr/Upwork profile

Step 2: Upload your sample work

Step 3: Write a gig like:

- “I will create YouTube video timestamps, subtitles & scenes breakdown”
- “I help YouTubers edit long videos into Shorts with story-based cuts”

Step 4: Apply to tasks on Remotasks, Appen, and Scale.ai

Optional: DM small creators on Instagram/YouTube:

“Hey! I create video chapters and clean subtitles. Can I try it on one of your videos for free? If you like it, we can work together.”

Earning Estimate

For Beginner (India)

300 to 500 Per Video

₹100–₹250 per minute of subtitling

₹400–₹1000 per reel edit or repurpose


₹15,000–₹35,000/month if consistent

For Foreign Clients

\$5–\$15/hr

Up to ₹1.2L/month as a video VA





Dont Do this Mistake

- Waiting for perfect English
- Thinking you need a YouTube channel
- Applying without samples
- Focusing only on "money" instead of “solving need”
